**Role of Promoters in running M-SETI**

**Bank of Maharashtra :**

Bank of Maharashtra has provided a corpus of Rs. 325.00 lakh. Bank has deputed six senior managers for the five centers of the Institute. It has provided a very spacious premises of 4000 sq. ft. at Hadapsar in it's own building. It has also provided all the necessary fixed assets for running the institute. Similarly, at Aurangabad and Nasik, M-SETI is operating from the premises owned by Bank of Maharashtra. In case of Nagpur centre, the institute is operating in the premises provided by the State Government on reasonable maintenance charges. Amravati centre has started working in the rental premises of Shri Hanuman Vyayam Prasarak Mandal.

**National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) :**

NABARD is associated with Bank of Maharashtra since April 2001 for this specific project. We are very proud to say that NABARD is one of the promoters. During the period of April 2001 to December 2001 (month of establishment of M-SETI), we had

several rounds of talks with officials of NABARD for the draft formulation of the scheme.

- NABARD has reimbursed 50 % of the fixed and recurring costs incurred by M-SETI during the financial year 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05.
- It has been reimbursing 50 % of recurring cost since 2005 (fourth year).
- NABARD is associated in the process of deciding policy framework of the Institute as well as in the implementation stage.
- CGM, NABARD Regional Office Pune is member of Governing Council of M-SETI.
- NABARD is appropriately represented in other forums of M-SETI as Administrative Council and Local Advisory Committee.

- It gives adequate representation to M-SETI in various workshops and seminars related on the subject of Enterprise Education.
- NABARD representative is a panel member for selection of candidates for every course.

**Government of Maharashtra (Deptt. Of Employment & Self Employment) :**

Officials of Deptt. of Employment & Self Employment help M-SETI in the selection of candidates. Government of Maharashtra is also represented in various councils of M-SETI.

- Employment Department, Government of Maharashtra is associated in the process of deciding policy framework of the Institute as well as in the implementation stage.
- Secretary, Employment Department is member of Governing Council of M-SETI.
- Employment Department is appropriately represented in other forums of M-SETI as Administrative Council and Local Advisory Committee.

**Objectives of M-SETI :**

- To transform the unemployed youth to acquire productive identity.
- To assist the unemployed youth to take up self employment ventures as an alternative career.
- To promote entrepreneurship.
- To empower the unemployed youth to share economic progress equitably.
- To continuously follow the trainees as regards their improvement, settlement, counseling them for Bank facilities etc.

**Selection Procedure :**

- 1) Joint Director of M-SETI participates in the gathering of unemployed youth at Block Level Meets. Candidates are selected after detailed interview.
- 2) Unemployed youth visit the Institute on an ongoing basis. Selection is made based on interview at the institute also.
- 3) Participation in the awareness programmes organized by NGOs.
- 4) Publicity of every course is made in the local newspapers of all districts from command area in co-ordination with District Information Officers of respective districts.
- 5) Interviews are conducted on pre-decided dates at the Institute for each course. Technical Faculty for the respective course and representatives from NABARD as well as Employment Department represent the Interview Panel along with the Joint Director.

**Eligibility Criterion for Selection of candidates for Training :**

- 1) Age : 18 to 35 years (relaxable on merit)
- 2) Education : Minimum S.S.C. or equivalent (relaxable on merit)
- 3) Experience : Primary knowledge of the proposed activity preferred.
- 4) Registration with Employment Exchange preferred.
- 5) Applicants for loans under Government sponsored schemes are preferred.
- 6) Applicant should be unemployed.
- 7) Applicant should have an aptitude towards self employment.

- 12) Solar Water Heater Repairs & Maintenance

Authorities, Networking amongst the trained candidates for co-ordination of various complementary services rendered, recommending the names of the candidate to established businessmen for providing ancillary services.
- Credit needs of the trained candidates are taken care of.

### **Fees for the Programme :**

- M-SETI conducts the programmes free of cost which includes arrangements for **lodging and boarding** also.
