Bank of Maharashtra joins hands with Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI)

Orientation programme for enrolment of data begins

Under the MoU signed with Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) as its registrar, Bank of Maharashtra held an Orientation programme for its executives for 'Aadhaar' scheme initiated by the Central Government for issuing unique identification numbers to each and every citizen of the country.

The Orientation programme for enrolment procedures and other modalities pertaining to the scheme was held at Central Office, Pune on 20th November 2010.

Dr. Viren Shah from UIDAI lectured on the modalities for enrolment for 'aadhaar' scheme. As a registrar, the Bank can enroll residents in the UID Project and assist the authority in various stages of the project.

Executive Director, Shri. M.G. Sanghvi spoke on the occasion and senior executives of the Bank were present.

Bank of Maharashtra has set up a Core Team to oversee the implementation of the UID project among the constituents, account holders, nominees and other individuals associated with it.

Unique identification numbers (UID) will be issued to the residents of India based on demographic and biometric data of the individual. UIDAI is partnering with Government and other agencies leveraging their existing infrastructure in order to implement the UID project.

UIDAI has set standards and processes for enrolment to be uniformly followed by all Registrars and Enrolling Agencies. The UIDAI will issue UIDs after checking that the resident applying for UID does not already have a record and a UID number in the UID database (de-duplication). In addition, the UIDAI will provide online, real-time Authentication service.

Under the MoU, Bank of Maharashtra will co-operate and collaborate with the UIDAI in conducting proof of concept (PoC) studies and pilots to test the working of the technology and process of enrolment into the UID database and subsequently full roll out of the UID project.

The Bank will provide resources to carry out the enrolment processes as per the phasing decided by UIDAI and Cooperate and collaborate with and provide all assistance and support to the officials and representatives of UIDAI.
